Narrative Nuggets:

In addition to describing the Holy Spirit as a gift, he is described as our Advocate (see John 15:26). In other words: a Helper, Encourager or Mediator.

How has the Holy Spirit been a helper, encourager and mediator to you in your walk with God? When you think of being a helper, encourager or a mediator to someone, what comes to mind? How does this help you to understand the Holy Spirit's role in our lives?

Laying the Brick (Application)

The Holy Spirit is working to mold us into the likeness of Jesus each and every day of our lives (1 Cor 3.18).
